

E-Poster Presentation Guidelines

Please note:

All speakers are requested to include a slide disclosing conflicts of interest at the beginning of their presentation

Electronic Posters or e-posters are similar to traditional paper posters but displayed on-site on a large LCD television screen.

Viewers will be able to easily find and browse e-posters. E-Posters will be available at the e-poster stations at the Conference or accessing with your computer, tablet or smartphone the Congress website during the Conference.

These posters do not require printing or production of materials – as your work will be presented electronically.

There will be an E-Poster Session for podium presentation and discussion of the 10 best e-posters chosen by the Scientific Program Committee.

If your e-poster is selected, please, prepare and pre-train your podium abstract speech for exactly 4 minutes (a four-minute presentation containing no more than 3 to 5 slides).

The projecting system is automatic and will switch off after 4:30 minutes.

All accepted posters must be uploaded to the congress website.

Please submit your poster as a 1-page PDF-file in portrait orientation.

File format: PDF

In Pixel: **1080 x 1920 (in centimeters 28.575 X 50.8)**

Portrait orientation

Media: Pictures, graphs and tables can be included in the e-Poster

Multimedia: videos and music cannot be included in the e-Poster

Font size: 16

Conventional printed posters will not be considered.
